lovely tune, from the collection called 'In the Quiet' published by GIA
G-5976 or separately, G-5977 or through Decani (UK agents)
- 6) 'Magnificat - (Holy is his name) John Michael Talbot
(apols - no other details known.)
- 7*) 'Alleluia' Brian Hamill 2009, adapted from a
Cistercian chant, a Gospel Acclamation for the Christmas day Mass.
- 8) L93 'Christmas is coming' John Bell 1992 WGRG
- we didn't warm to it!
- 9) L65⁺ 'Advent wreath service' John Schiavone OCP
For each Sunday in Advent, there is a text to accompany the lighting
of the advent wreath, and ⁺a setting of the Kyrie with appropriate
advent tropes.
- 10) VE1a 'Await the Lord with Hope' Bob Hurd 1996 OCP
- also in Bob Hurd's collection 'Ubi Caritas' (OCP) along with some
other very useful stuff

- 11*) 'Angels Guardian' Brian Hamill 2009 (words)
Tune is 'Morning has broken'
- 12) 'Saviour Lord' hymn, (beautiful) music by John from St
Benedict's, author of words not known.

- 14*) 'O Holy Night' Arranged by Nicki Allan
- what a great hymn!
- 15) VE p 177 'Hodie Christus Natus Est'
Magnificat antiphon from Evening Prayer for Christmas Day
